
From the newsroom.....

Dear All,



Looking forward to having our new learners and our little seniors aboard!






Muffin Morning

Transition


Children visited their new class where they were regaled with stories and art activities.

Children enjoyed playing on the slides and other equipment in the play area. They shared their goodies with friends and teachers.








BASKETBALL HEROES in action
